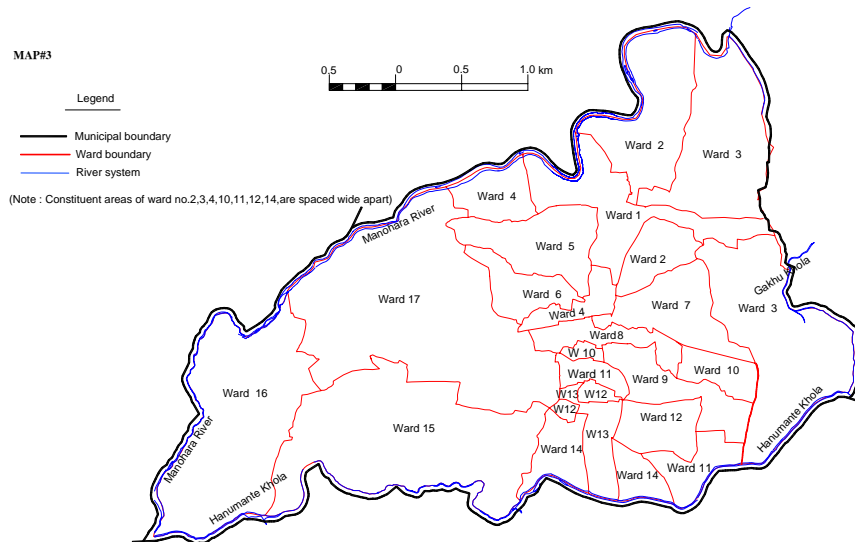

MADHYAPUR THIMI MUNICIPALITY

Madhyapur Thimi municipality lies in Bhaktapur district of Central Development Region. It covers an area of 11.47 sq. km. According to Population Census 2001, this municipality had a density of 4298 persons per sq. km. It was declared municipality in 2053 B.S. Its socio-economic characteristics are described below.

A. POPULATION AND MIGRATION

Madhyapur Thimi municipality spread in 17 wards accounts 9551 households with an average number of 561.8 households/wards and average household size 5.0. Comparatively the ward number 16 has more household followed by ward 10 and 6. The municipality counts up 47751 population representing 52 per cent male and 48 per cent female. There is no remarkable proportion of in the distribution of population in wards by gender (Indv_Table1).

The distribution of population by five years age group and sex show relatively leading proportion in age group 10-14 (11.5 %) followed by 5-9 (9.7 %) and 0-4 (7.3 %) respectively. Out of the total population the majority 64.9 per cent fall in economically active (15-59) age group. By gender, male population led in most of the age group below 15 years. In age group of 60 and above female population led to the male by 4 per cent (Indv_Table 2).

Out of the total population of Madhyapur Thimi Municipality 114 people own the citizenship of other countries representing the highest (83.3 %) from India. The others are from other Asian countries 7.9 per cent, Bangladesh 6.1 per cent, Sri Lanka 1.7 per cent and others 0.9 per cent. Comparatively the ward number 15 and 12 has higher number of the foreign citizenship (Indv_Table 6).

Disable population in the municipality are only 111 persons (0.2 %) of which 41 per cent are male and 59 per cent female. Out of the total disable population 47 per cent are physically disable, 22.5 per cent deaf, 9 per cent blind, 9.9 per cent mentally retarded and 11.7 per cent multiple disable. The number of disable population is higher in ward number 15 and 12 respectively (Indv_Table7).

Most of the populations of Madhyapur Thimi municipality (99.5%) are native born and 72.1 per cent born in the same district. Out of the total foreign born (241) population 50 per cent are male and 50 per cent female. Ward number 15, 16, 17 and 13 has comparatively higher number of foreign born population. Among the native born population 27.4 per cent are born in the other district with rural born remarkably higher than urban born (Indv_Table10).

The population aged 10 and over is 39606 representing 60.3 per cent married, 39.2 per cent living single and 0.93 per cent not stated. Out of the total married population 49 per cent are male and 51 per cent female. The majority (94 %) have single spouse, 0.8 per cent remarried and 3.6 per cent widow. The proportion of divorced and separated is very low in comparison to those living with one spouse. The majority of widows (74.5 %) are female (Indv_Table11).

Madhyapur Thimi municipality consist 30.9 per cent population under 16 years of age accounting 52 per cent male and 48 per cent female. The status of living arrangement of the majority (88.6 %) is with parents followed by 2.9 per cent with mothers, 2.6 per cent with others and 1.4 per cent with father. There is no remarkable difference in status of living arrangements by gender. However, living arrangements with mother is comparatively higher in ward number 17, 15 and 13 of the municipality (Indv_Table17).

B. HOUSING CONDITIONS

Type of house/housing unit

Type of house/housing unit can be one of the many indicators of the quality of life of an urban household. Based on the use of building materials, four broad categories of house or housing unit in municipality can be sorted. These are *pakki* or concrete (brick and cement, cement and iron), semi *pakki* or partly concrete (partly brick and cement), *kachh* or non concrete (local materials: stone, mud and wood) and others. The house/housing units composition in the

municipality is dominated by *pakki* ones (HH_Table 1). About 84 % of the house/housing units in whole municipality are *pakki* types. However, significant variation in composition can be noticed in different wards. The proportion of non *pakki* types are considerable high in the ward no. 3,5, 16 and 17 i.e. (25-66%) . Among the non *pakki* ones, semi *pakki* is common type in most wards.

Ownership of house/housing unit

Ownership pattern of the house/housing unit in the municipality indicates that the urban activity is in premature phase because a very **small number** (low proportion) of house/housing units are used for non-residential purpose. About 66% of the house/housing unit is used by household themselves (HH_Table 2), which is non-commercial. This proportion is above 80% in 9 out of 17 wards. In ward no 15, 16 and 17, owing to the concentration of offices and institutions and business activity, the proportion is relatively (40-51%) high for non self residential use. Hence, the ownership pattern implies that urban activity is localized in a few wards and most house/housing units in large part of municipality are not economic.

Female ownership on house and land

Gender disparity in ownership is highly acute (HH_Table 10). The traditional pattern of ownership prevails in the municipality where male commands over ownership on the basic assets like house and land. In all wards, more than 90% of women do not have ownership on either land or house or both This implies vast majority of women are devoid of ownership rights making them economically and socially vulnerable.

Gender and household head

There is a relatively gender imbalance in terms of household head in the municipality (Indv_Table 18). Male overwhelmingly dominates the number of household head i.e. 88 % of the total. In an average, there are about 7 male headed households for each female counterpart. Compared to average municipality in hill it is high. Ward wise, some significant variation in proportion of head by female (9-18 %) sex could be detected which indicates a tendency towards gender balance, although much better could be achieved.

C. SOCIO-ECONOMIC ASPECTS

Literacy Status

Of the total population 6 years of age and over (43280) in Madhyapur Thimi municipality, 72.6 percent is literate. Male literacy is 82.7 percent and female 61.8 percent (Indv_Table 8). Compared with national average, the total overall literacy is higher (national average 53.7 percent).

Educational Attainment

Among total literate population (31417) in the municipality 28.8 percent has attained Primary education only, 18.1 percent Lower Secondary and 14.8 percent Secondary education. Literates with SLC constituted 11.4 percent. The proportion attaining higher education i.e., beyond SLC is 14.4 percent only (Indv_Table 9).

Religion

An overwhelming majority is of Hindu population (87.8 percent). The remaining population belongs to Bouddha (10.9 percent), Kirat (0.4 percent), Christian (0.4 percent), Islam (0.3 percent) and other religions (Indv_Table 3).

Caste and Ethnic Composition

There are many caste/ethnic groups in the municipality. Among them Newar (61.1 percent), Chhetri (12.5 percent) and Brahman-hill (11.0 percent) are the main caste/ethnic groups (Indv_Table 4). Others are Tamang (4.5 percent), Magar (2.0 percent) and Rai (1.2 percent). Other caste/ethnic groups with less than 1 percent population each in the municipality are Sarki, Gurung, Tharu, Sherpa, Bhote, Damai/Dholi, Thakuri, Sanyasi, Muslim, Yadav, Limbu, Kayastha, Kami, Mallah and Teli.

Mother Tongue

Newari is the mother tongue of 59.5 percent population in Madhyapur Thimi municipality (Indv_Table 5). Other linguistic groups are Nepali (32.3 percent), Tamang (4.4 percent), Bantawa (0.5 percent), Tharu (0.3 percent), Gurung (0.3 percent), Hindi (0.3 percent), Limbu (0.2 percent), Sherpa (0.2 percent), Bhojpuri (0.2 percent) and Urdu (0.1 percent).

School Attendance

Of the total population aged 6 to 25 years (16889), 74.5 percent is attending school. This school attendance is 76.2 percent for boys and 72.7 percent for girls (Indv_Table 19).

D. ECONOMY AND EMPLOYMENT SITUATION

The Table 3 represents the number of households by land used for agriculture purpose for Madhyapur Thimi Municipality. It is interesting to see that the municipal households with land use for agriculture purpose are lesser which consists 48%. Ward no. 15, 16 and 17 have very few land use for agriculture purpose which is only about 22% of the total households (Indv_Table 3 Annex 1).

The Table 4 shows the number of households by small scale household economic activities of the municipality. More than 65% of the households have no economic activity in the municipality. Only about 15% of the total households have adopted business and about 8% have services. Other activities are very less. The figure shows that most of the business activities are concentrated in ward no. 1, 2, 3, 13, 15 and 16 in which, about 64% households of the business activities are engaged in this municipality (Indv_Table 4 Annex 1).

The Table 12 represents the population 10 years of age and over by usual activity performed (activity performed most of the time) in the last 12 months (preceding the census) by sex. Majority of the 10 years and over is engaged in study (29%) which is followed by wage/salary earning (19%), household chores (17%), own agriculture (15%), and own non-agriculture is 12% of the total population of this municipality. Similarly, in study category the proportion is 30% female and 27% male. Likewise the situation is very distinct in the case of household chores where about 34% of female and only 1% of male is engaged. After these, own agricultural activity is dominated in the municipality which is just over 20% of the total households in which 15% male and 14% female are involved (Table 12 Annex 1).

The Table 13 shows the population 10 years of age and over by economic activity by sex. It indicates that almost 56 percent of the populations are economically active and remaining is not. Similarly the proportion of the economically active and not active by sex indicates that 69 percent of male and 31 percent female are economically active and 41 and 59 percent not economically active population of the municipality. Likewise, the number of not usually economic active population is significantly lesser than the not economically active, which consists about less than two percent of the total population 10 years of age and above (Table 13 Annex 1).

The Table 14 indicates the employed population 10 years of age and over by occupation by sex. Almost 35 percent of the populations are engaged in skilled and semi-skilled agricultural and fishery workers. Likewise craft (21%), service workers and shop and market sales workers are 14% and elementary occupations are 7% of the total households of this municipality. The remaining populations are in other sectors, i.e. professional and technical as well as non-technical sectors. Moreover, the agriculture ranks as the first important occupation on which about 29% of male and 48% of female are involved. Likewise, the craft are also distinct in this municipality where about 20% female and only 22% male are involved. Other occupations are dominated by the male population (Indv_Table 14 Annex 1).

The Table 15 indicates the employed population 10 years of age and over by industry by sex. It is clearly seen that relatively higher proportion of population are engaged in agriculture and

forest related activities in this municipality. More than 37 percent of the total population of 10 years of age and over is engaged in this activity which is followed by manufacturing (24%) and wholesale and retail trade (12%). Similarly, the proportion of male is higher than the female in all sectors except agriculture (50% female and 30% male) (Indv_Table 15 Annex 1).

The Table 16 illustrates the status of employment population 10 years of age and over by sex. It is clearly seen that majority of the households are self account workers which consists more than 51% which is followed by employee (42%). The proportion of female and male are higher in the status of employee and self-employee than others which consists 47% male and 33% female and 49% male and 57% female respectively (Indv_Table 16 Annex 1).

E. ENERGY AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

The situation of energy and infrastructures utilization and development in municipal area indicate state of environment and development. Environmental conservation is a common concern of all development efforts in municipal area.

The major sources of energy for cooking are firewood, kerosene and Lpgas in most of the municipalities in Nepal. Besides, Biogas, Santhi and other sources of energy are also used for cooking in various places. Although there are many sources of energy of cooking, **59 percent** households depend upon **kerosene in Madhyapur Thimi** municipality depend upon firewood for cooking. Besides kerosene, **about 22 percent households depend on wood and about 17 percent on lpgas** for the purpose of cooking. As given in HH_table 6 below, energy sources is not stated for **80 households and 124 households use other** then above mentioned sources of energy for cooking. About one third households in ward no 1,2,8,9, 10, 11 and 14 **use firewood** for cooking. Kerosene is the important sources of cooking energy in all wards. However, lpgas is mostly used in ward no 15, 16 and 17 of the municipality.

Besides cooking, lighting is another important sector of energy utilization. The major sources of energy for the purpose for lighting especially in the municipal areas in Nepal are electricity and kerosene. As given in HH_table no 7 below, **about 98 percent households in Madhyapur Thimi** municipality use electricity for lighting. Only **1 percent households use kerosene**. Energy

sources are not stated of 87 (0.91%) households. Most of the households in all wards use electricity.

Very few households i.e. 11 use other various type of energy for the purpose of lighting in Madhyapur Thimi municipality.

Transport and communication are very important aspects of development. These infrastructures make like easier and faster by bringing goods, people and information from one place to another place. Regarding the Madhyapur Thimi municipality, about 77 percent households have radio, 72 percent households have television and 5 percent households have refrigerator. About 18 percent households of the municipality have telephone facility.

As given in HH_table 9 above, telephone facility is available in all wards but it is very limited in ward no 6 of the municipality. More than 70 percent households in all wards of the municipality have radio and television.

Many households in all wards have motor car, motorcycle, refrigerator facilities. Very limited households in ward no 6 and 11 have such assets.

F. HEALTH AND SANITATION

Although households of Madhyapur Thimi Municipality are getting drinking water from various sources, coverage of piped water (tap) is the highest. Out of total households, 55 percent get pipe water. After the tap, well, and tubewell rank the second, and the third important sources respectively. Out of the total, about 24 and 16 percent households receive drinking water from well and tubewell respectively in Madhyapur Thimi (see in Annex 1). Besides these sources, 3 percent households fetch water from the spring, and negligible proportion depends on other sources.

The proportions of households depending on piped water as the source of drinking water have little variation except in ward no. 15. Most of the households of all wards except in ward no. 15 are using piped water. However, about 53 and 30 percent households of ward no. 15 are depending on tubewell and well for drinking water. The percentage of households using tube well for drinking water is ranging from 1 percent in ward no. 10 as the least proportion to 53 percent in ward no. 15 as the highest. Similarly, the percentage of households using well for drinking water is ranging from 3 percent in ward no. 1 as the least to 43 percent in ward no. 16 as the highest proportion. Beside these sources, about 17 percent households of ward no. 10 are depending on other sources.

Most of the households of Madhyapur Thimi Municipality have toilet facility. Among the total households of the municipality, about 48 percent have modern flush toilet and about 40 percent have ordinary toilet. However, about 11 percent households still use open toilet.

The proportion of household with different toilet facility is varying in different wards in Madhyapur Thimi Municipality. The proportion of households using modern toilet is ranging from 10 percent as the least in wards no. 2 to 99 percent as the highest in ward no. 14. The proportions of households using modern toilet are significantly higher in ward no. 4 and 14. Similarly, the proportion of households having ordinary toilet is ranging from 0 percent in ward no 14 to 75 percent in ward no. 16. Contrary to this the proportion of households having no toilet is ranging from 0 percent in ward no. 14 to 49 percent in ward no 3. Still, almost 5 percent of households of 5, 11, and 17 wards do not state their toilet facility there.
